- Backgammon Finnish Open has reached its 50th edition and we are excited to organize the anniversary tournament in the heart of the capital: 4-star Clarion hotel Mestari, meaning "master". Fitting name!
- After warming up on Friday, players may travel in *Business* or *Economy class* where the format is swiss, followed by play-offs and consolation, and last chance. Those new to the scene can test their wings in 3-elimination flight *Learn to fly*. In Business and Economy everyone is guaranteed at least 38 points worth of play and in Learn to fly at least 21 points. Win and you get to play more!
- Speedgammon, DMP-tournament, cancelgammon and four player jackpots of varying sizes are also available.

VENUE & DATE

- **Clarion hotel Mestari**

- The house of master builders was built in 1932 and has a rich cultural history. Clarion hotel Mestari is the newest link in the chain. FORMAT

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY CLASSES

1. SWISS STAGE: 3 x 11 p. (max. 16 players) or 4 x 7 p. (17-32 players). Tournament is run with Drawboss software. During swiss players with the same record are paired, if possible. Bye is awarded to a player with the worst record. Only one bye per player until all remaining players have got a bye. Players can only face each other once, if possible. Next round will be drawn when all of the matches of the current round have been finished.
2. PLAY-OFF STAGE: After swiss player(s) who won all their matches go(es) to main semi-final cup bracket. Those who suffered one loss during swiss will play a cup bracket in main quarter-finals to fill rest of the semi-final spots. If a player got a bye during swiss, he/she can't get another in quarter-finals.
3. CONSOLATION STAGE:
 - Players who didn't make it to the play-off stage after swiss will play a seeded cup bracket, the winner of which is the consolation semi-finalist #1. The seeding will be decided according to swiss standings.
 - Players who lose in main quarter-finals will play a cup bracket, the winner of which is consolation semi-finalist #3.
 - Two players who lose in the main semi-finals will fill the last two consolation semi-final spots (consolation semi-finalists #2 and #4).
 - All players will eventually fall to consolation, except main finalists.
4. LAST CHANCE STAGE: Players who lose in consolation will fall to last chance stage. All players will eventually fall to last chance, except consolation finalists.
 - The ranking of the tournament is main 1, main 2, conso 1, conso 2 etc... Sidepools will follow to consolation stage.
 - Clock obligation: 2 min / point + 12 seconds delay

FORMAT

LEARN TO FLY

- Swiss with triple elimination - Last chance - DMP-tournament
- Tournament is run with Drawboss software. During swiss players with the same record are paired, if possible. Bye is awarded to a player with the worst record. Only one bye per player until all remaining players have got a bye. Players can only face each other once, if possible. Next round will be drawn when all of the matches of the current round have been finished.
- Player is eliminated after 3 losses.
- When a player is eliminated he/she will fall to last chance- tournament. However players who cash in main tournament don't go to last chance.
- All players will participate in a 1-point cup bracket, DMP-tournament
- Clock option: 3 min / point + 15 seconds delay (clocks are recommended)

Business class

- Swiss 3 x 11 pts. (max. 16 players) OR
- Swiss 4 x 7 pts. (17-32 players)
- Main quarter-finals:
 - 11 pts. (if only one round)
 - 7 pts. (if two rounds)
- Main semi-finals: 11 pts.
- Main final 15 pts.
- Consolation: 5 pts.
- Consolation final: 9 pts.
- Last chance: 5 pts.

Economy class

- Swiss 3 x 11 pts. (max. 16 players) OR
- Swiss 4 x 7 pts. (17-32 players)
- Main quarter-finals:
 - 11 pts. (if only one round)
 - 7 pts. (if two rounds)
- Main semi-finals: 11 pts.
- Main final 13 pts.
- Consolation: 5 pts.
- Consolation final: 7 pts.
- Last chance: 5 pts.

Learn to fly

- Triple elimination match length will be decided according to attendance, most likely 5 pts. Final rounds might be shortened / extended based on the schedule.
- Last chance: 5 pts.
- DMP-tournament 1 p.

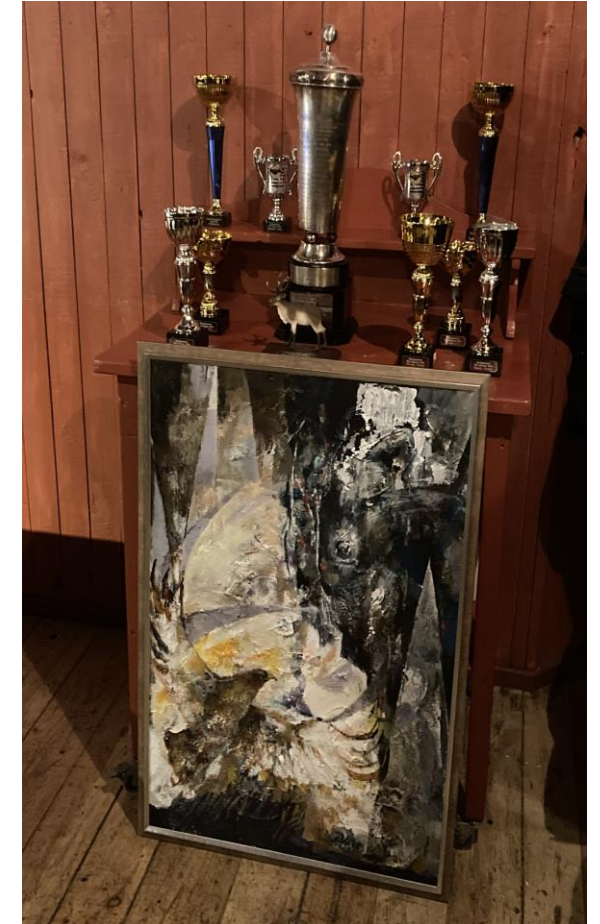
