Those new to the scene can test their wings in 3-elimination flight *Learn to fly*. Speedgammon, DMP-tournament, and four player jackpots are also available.

- Karhumäentie 5, Vantaa
- The stylish conference hotel which was built in 2016 is located right next to the Helsinki-Vantaa airport.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY CLASSES

MAX. 16 PLAYERS IN A CLASS

1. SWISS 3 x 11 p. with double elimination.
 2. FINAL BRACKET
 - Players who survived the swiss stage will play in the final bracket, which is seeded according to swiss standings. Players who won 3 / 3 in swiss will get a bye, and if that is not possible, 5 % of the prize pool.
 3. LAST CHANCE
 - All other players will play in the Last chance tournament on Sunday, besides the main semifinalists.
- Clock obligation: 2 min / point + 12 seconds delay

17 - 32 PLAYERS IN A CLASS

1. PROGRESSIVE CONSOLATION 11 / 9 p.
2. LAST CHANCE
 - All other players will play in the Last chance tournament on Sunday, besides the main finalists and consolation finalists. Clock obligation: 2 min / point + 12 seconds delay

FORMAT

LEARN TO FLY

- Swiss with triple elimination – Last chance
- Tournament is run with Drawboss software. During swiss players with the same record are paired, if possible. Bye is awarded to a player with the worst record. Only one bye per player until all remaining players have got a bye. Players can only face each other once, if possible. Next round will be drawn when all of the matches of the current round have been finished.
- Player is eliminated after 3 losses.
- When a player is eliminated he/she will fall to Last chance-tournament, played on Sunday. However players who cash in main tournament don't go to Last chance.
- It's difficult to estimate the number of rounds in the tournament, but the main final will be played on Sunday in any case.
- Clock option: 3 min / point + 15 seconds delay (clocks are recommended)

ARRIVAL TO THE HOTEL

- **Clarion Hotel Aviapolis** - Karhumäentie 5, Vantaa
- Please note, that there are several hotels within the airport with similar sounding names.
- 1,5 km from the Helsinki-Vantaa airport terminals. From the airport: Take the I train for 2 minutes (one stop), get off at the Aviapolis stop and get off in the direction of Aviabulevardi. You can also get to the hotel by bus (1-2 stops), with the nearest stops being Teknikontie and Mekaanikontie.
- From the centre of Helsinki, the main railway station: The I and P trains run along the Ring Road between the centre of Helsinki and the airport and stop at the second line station at Aviapolis. Get off at the station in the direction of Aviabulevardi. You can also get there by bus number 600, which has a stop at the hotel on Teknikonti.
- ~20 km Katajanokka terminal (Viking Line) & Olympia terminal (Tallink & Silja Line)
